

WELCOME TO A STUDY OF THE BLENDED GOSPELS

Why study all four Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, John) at the same time? It helps us see the complete picture of the Life and Ministry of Jesus Christ. We will see how the Gospels fit together and bring us the bigger picture. We will see how God wove all four of these accounts together to give us a truly inspired look at Christ the Messiah, the Servant, the Man, and the Incarnate Word of God. By studying all four Gospels together, we will see the clearest picture of Christ.



Section One "Now THE TIME HAS COME" covers some of the Old Testament prophecies concerning the coming Messiah up through His miracle performed at a wedding in Cana. \$10.00

Section Two "WRITTEN THAT WE MIGHT BELIEVE" opens with the first Passover Jesus attends at the start of His ministry and ends with the "Sermon on the Mount". \$12.00

Section Three "JESUS DOES THE WILL OF THE FATHER" opens with the healing of the Centurion's slave and ends with Jesus walking on the water. \$12.00

Section Four "JESUS IS REJECTED BY HIS OWN" concentrates on the Jewish rejection of Jesus as the Christ, the prophesied Messiah. Their blindness leads them into unbelief and rejection of the very Messiah who had come to free them from their bondage of sin. \$9.00

Section Five "Jesus Turns to the Cross, Part 1" Jesus opens this section of scripture by asking His disciples who the people think He is. Jesus also reveals to the disciples that He is the Messiah and that He will soon die. Jesus is preparing His disciples by teaching them about the "cost" of following Him and the discipline of prayer. \$14.00

Section Six: "JESUS TURNS TO THE CROSS, PART 2" Jesus opens this section of scripture by continuing to teach his disciples by both His words and deeds. Jesus continues to tell His disciples that He must die soon. Jesus loves spending this precious time teaching and preparing them for His departure. \$12.00

Section Seven "THE LAST WEEK, PART 1" opens with Jesus staying with Lazarus in the town of Bethany. He is anointed with oil by Mary to prepare Him for His upcoming death on the cross. This section takes us through part of Jesus' last week before His appointment with the cross. This section ends with Jesus' warnings about false messiahs coming to them and saying they are the One. \$12.00

Section Eight "THE LAST WEEK, PART 2" opens with Jesus giving them hints as to how they will know when He is returning to them as He continues to remind them they He must depart very soon. This section ends with Jesus praying for His disciples and even for those who would believe in the future. \$10.00

Section Nine "THE END OF THE BEGINNING" opens with Jesus praying in the Garden of Gethsemane asking God to take the cup from Him. This section ends with Jesus declaring....." Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." \$12.00

WELCOME TO THE ACTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT SERIES

Author: Luke, writing to Theophilus

Main Characters: The Apostles and the working of the Holy Spirit

ACTS Section One **Section 1**: (12 weeks) Luke is writing to Theophilus explaining all that has happened since Jesus had been taken up to heaven. You will learn about Pentecost and the powerful way Peter is used to speak with boldness the Truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. You will see how the Apostles have been empowered not only to preach but to heal. In this portion of Scripture you will study the call of Saul (Paul) on the road to Damascus. You will also see how the Word of God spreads more and more. You will study the early persecution and meet the first martyrs. Peter's vision that God has granted the Gentiles repentance is also in this section of Scripture. This section ends with God rescuing Peter from jail. Price: \$12.00

ACTS Section Two **Section 2**: (9 weeks) This second section of Acts opens with Saul (Paul) and Barnabas being "set apart for Christ" as missionaries to the Gentiles. The first missionary journey (Acts 13-14) was started as Paul and Barnabas encountered their first opposition from both the unbelieving Jews and those Jews who had believed in Jesus as their Messiah. You will also study the first letter that Paul wrote to the region of Galatia concerning this argument: "Does a Gentile believer need to be circumcised in order to be a true believer?" Paul argues passionately "may it never be!" He further states that Christ has freed the believer from the law and now he lives under grace. Both Jews and Gentiles are the same under God's grace separate from the law. Price: \$9.00

ACTS Section Three Section 3: (10 weeks) Chapter 15 of Acts opens this section of the study of the "Acts of the Holy Spirit" with Paul heading back to Jerusalem to go to the elders to settle the issue of circumcision and salvation. After great debate James wrote a letter to the church at Antioch stating that they would have full salvation without being circumcised. Paul starts out on his 2nd missionary journey in this section of scripture (Acts 15:36) to check on the believers. I & II Thessalonians will be studied in this section which shows the power of the Holy Spirit in action. These earlier believers were under great persecution and you will see how the Holy Spirit enabled them to "stand strong" in the truth of the Gospel. Price: \$10.00

ACTS Section Four **Section 4**: (9 weeks) The ongoing study of the ACTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT opens with Paul continuing his second Missionary journey. We find Paul preaching in the Gentile city of Corinth. He once again declares that he is going to bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles because of the unending resistance from his fellow Jews. Their hard hearts and obstinate behavior to the truth of the Messiah makes Paul even more determined to preach to the Gentiles.

In this Section, Paul will also start his third Missionary journey, returning to many of the areas where he had started churches. He returns to encourage them to stay true to the truth of the Gospel of Christ and to do "all things in love". Price: \$9.00

ACTS Section Five **Section 5**: (9 weeks) In this final Section of the "Acts of the Holy Spirit" series we find Paul in Asia continuing his 3rd and last missionary journey. The Holy Spirit prompts Paul to head to Jerusalem and alerts him "that bonds and afflictions await." (Acts 20:23). As the Holy Spirit leads Paul back to Jerusalem and then on to Rome we see Paul's trust and faith in the One who leads him.

We know that the story of the Holy Spirit doesn't end with Paul and Acts 28. We can take comfort in knowing that the Holy Spirit continues to lead, direct, comfort and teach those who follow Him. The Holy Spirit is active in our lives and directs us for God's purpose. His acts continue through those who put their faith in Him. Price: \$9.00


Item #: PL1 Price-\$7.00

Paul wrote this letter to the churches he founded in the region of Galatia, warning them against certain false teachers. He reminds them of the simple message of salvation by faith alone.

I and II Thessalonians (10 Weeks) Hope in the Hard Times

Paul wrote this letter to the church he began in Thessalonica. He was excited about their Christian faith and reminds them of his intense love for them and answers questions about what death means for a Christian. Paul wrote the second letter to tells them that the antichrist is coming, and that they must continue in their Faith until Jesus returns

This letter was written to the church at Corinth during Paul's third and final missionary journey while at Ephesus. Paul addresses his concerns for the arrogance and lack of unity he has heard about in the Corinthian Church.



Il Corinthians (11 Weeks) How to Handle Conflicts Without and Fears Within


Item #: PL5 Price-\$11.00

Paul wrote this second letter to the church in Corinth from Macedonia while on his way to Corinth. As the most personal of all his letters, he expresses both how exciting and how painful his life as a missionary has been. He also finds it necessary to defend himself against those who are criticizing him.

The book of Romans is arguably Paul's finest letter. It was written as a compelling argument for what Christians ought to believe. To study this book will bring into focus what the whole Christian faith is all about.



Ephesians, Philemon & Colossians (12 Weeks) Light in a Dark World

Paul wrote **Ephesians** from prison to the church he started in Ephesus .In the first half he explains God's great plan to redeem the world through Christ, showing what this means for individual Christians and for the whole church. In the second half he gives practical advice on how to live the Christian life. **Philemon** This one chapter letter is such a good example as to how love changes everything. **Colossians** False teachers were deceiving some of those to whom Paul writes. He stresses the power and glory of Christ and instructs his readers on how to live as Christians.

Philippians, I Timothy, Titus & II Timothy (17 weeks) Instructions For The Next Generation

Item #: PL8 Price-\$17.00

Paul wrote **Philippians** to the church he started in Philippi .Even though he is in prison, he rejoices when he thinks of what Christ means to him and how the Philippians are staying faithful. He gives some very practical advice on how to live the Christian life. **I Timothy:** Paul wrote this letter to young Timothy, who is serving as a pastor in Ephesus. He instructs him in how organize and run the church and how to deal with false teachers and refute what they were saying. **Titus:** Paul writes to Titus, a pastor serving in Crete, to advise him both on what to teach the churches and on how to organize them, especially with false teachers around.

Il Timothy: This second letter to Timothy was written by Paul shortly before he is called home (Il Timothy 4:6-8). Times are difficult, both morally and spiritually, and he wants to encourage Timothy to persevere in his Christian faith.
